Election Night Rules

1. Wear full Class A uniform and arrive on time. This will ensure you get a ballot.
2. To be eligible to vote, you must be present.
3. To be eligible to be elected, you must be present.
4. Make sure you bring your leadership applications that have been filled out and signed. If you do not have these, you will not be considered or allowed to make a speech for your desired position
5. Nominations for all leadership positions must be approved by the Scoutmaster and are closed at 7pm on election night.
6. Candidates shall be prepared with speeches explaining their qualifications, and why they are worthy candidates for the position in question.
7. The order of the speeches will be random.
8. The voters may ask questions of the SPL and PL candidates upon the completion of their respective speeches
9. Everyone in attendance shall be respectful of the candidates during speeches.
10. Elections are by secret ballot.
11. No write-in votes will be considered.
12. Ballot cards are given to the JASM charged with monitoring the election.
13. Election results determined by majority vote.
14. The most important jobs (with respect to the chain of command) will go first (i.e. SPL, PL, Guide, Instructor, etc...)
15. Upon the election of the new SPL, he will take over the electoral process
